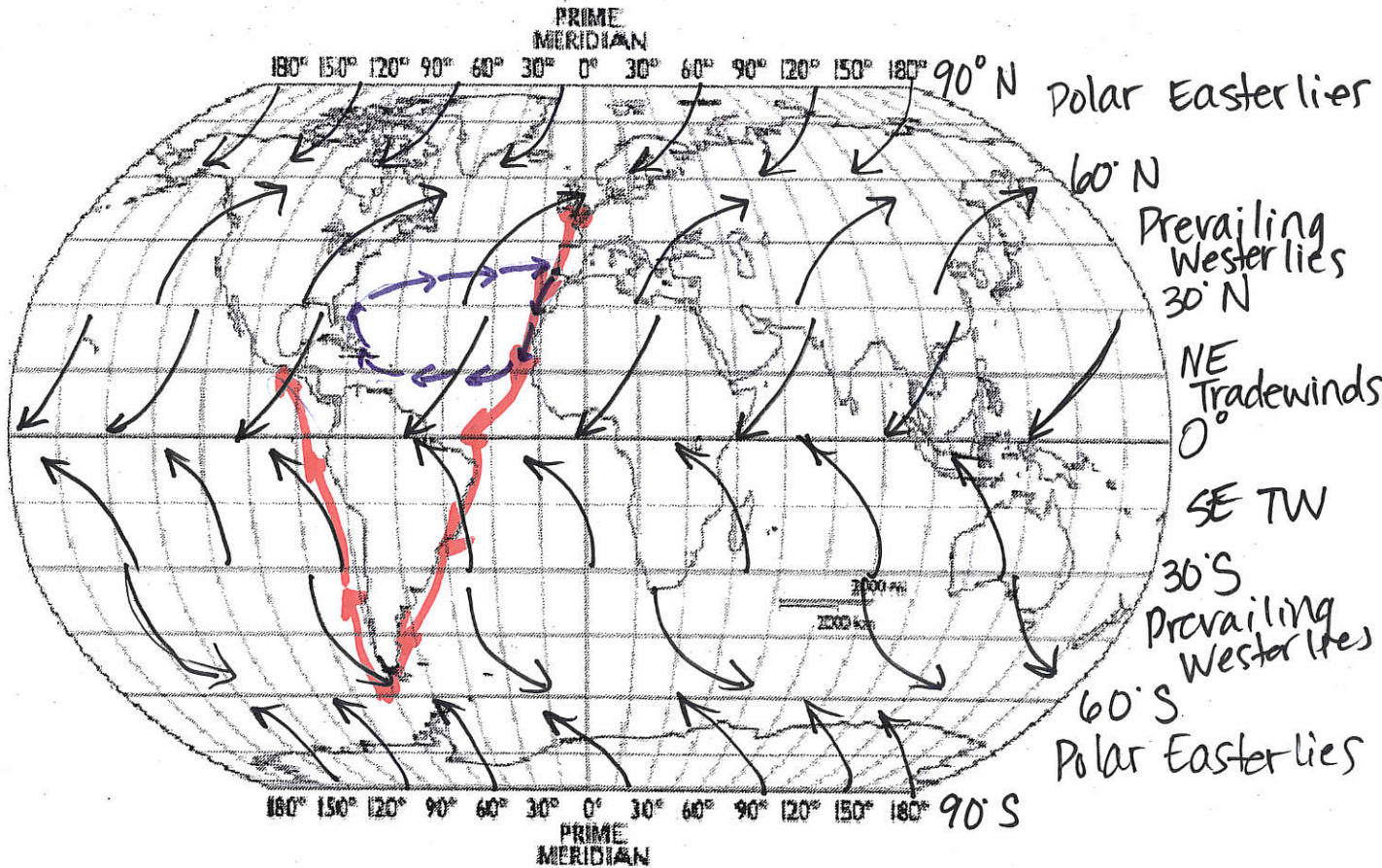


WIND ASSIGNMENT

Label all the winds with their characteristics. Ex. Arrows in the correct latitudes pointing in the correct direction and bending according to the Coriolis effect. Be sure to include degrees in the diagram.



Directions: On the map

- draw in the wind belts using **PURPLE** color to distinguish the easterlies and from the westerlies in **GREEN**. Make sure they are between the correct latitudes.
- Label the wind belts in neat capital letters and **BLACK**.

Figure out how you could sail from Portugal to Cuba and back using only the Global Wind Belts.

- Draw your route in **BLUE**
- List the windbelts in order you would use:

- Sail south along the coast to Africa & pickup NE tradewinds

- Sail north up coast of Florida + pickup prevailing westerlies

Now, how would you sail from London to San Fransisco? Draw your route in **RED**.
